This material is suitable for high school libraries and high school English courses, and for selected courses in English as a Second Language and the Social Sciences. All texts in this extensive multicultural bibliography are personally recommended. A version is available on CD requiring Microsoft Office Word 2003.

Annotations accompanying entries of the 200+ student texts provide the following:

- author’s/editor’s name, publication details, and ISBN to assist with ordering
- original publication date, genre, and total number of pages
- brief synopses of plot and/or textual content
- notes on story location and/or author’s nationality
- clear identification of indigenous authors and content



In addition, annotations of applicable student texts incorporate:

- cross referencing notations
- titles and key details of texts’ film versions

The five sections of this multicultural bibliography include:

- texts suggested for use in grade 9 and 10 courses: 60+ titles, annotations, and designations for both academic and applied courses
- texts suggested for use in grade 11 and 12 courses: 65+ titles and annotations
- texts suggested for use in university preparation courses: 75+ titles and annotations; includes more challenging content for students’ independent study projects
- teachers’ guides and other resources: with 50+ entries suggested for use by teacher-librarians and teachers, department heads/curriculum leaders, and course coordinators and curriculum developers at school board level
- publishers, distributors, suppliers, and websites: with company addresses, website and email addresses, and phone and fax numbers to assist with ordering
